**Cost:** A\$309 per student \* plus \$20 on arrival



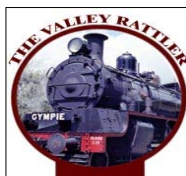

**Date:** Departs Daily

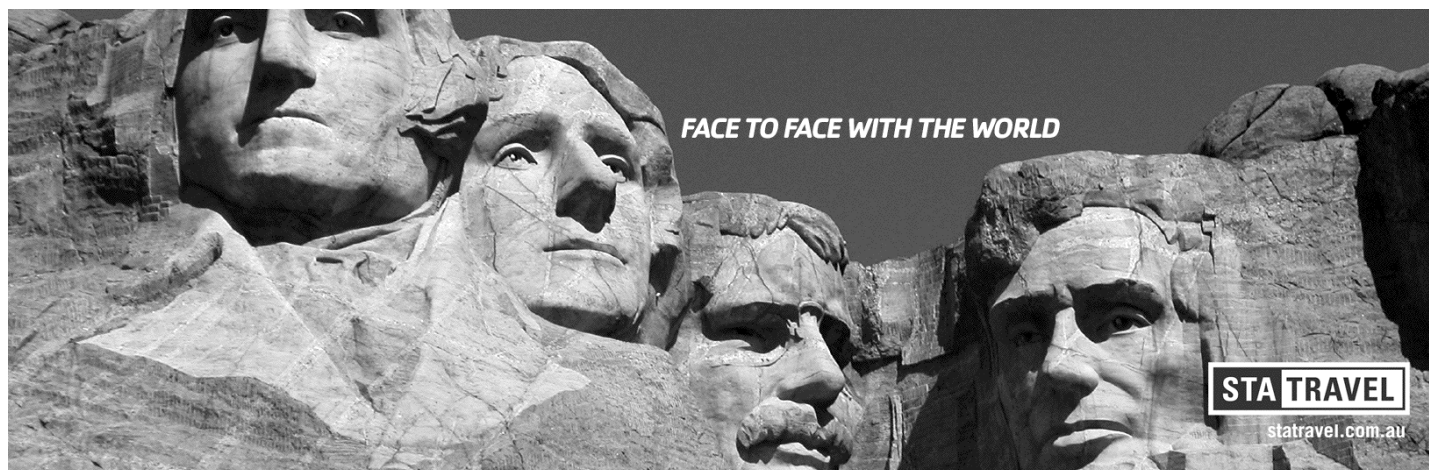
**Cost:** A\$45 per person \*
