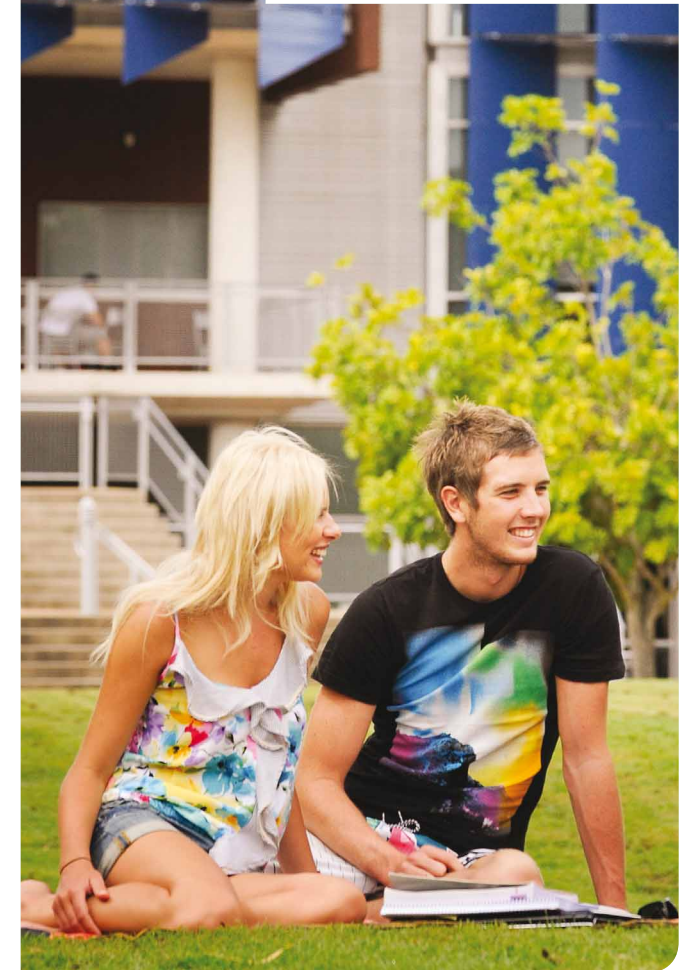

- USC's room numbering system is:
- Building name – level – room number
- Lecture theatres are identified by the letters LT and a number

Examples:
KG.45 = Building K, ground level, Room 45
LT7 = Lecture Theatre 7

Campus security

24 hours a day, 7 days a week

- Emergencies: 5430 1122

To raise an alarm in an emergency

- Call for assistance (yell "FIRE" for attention)
 - Dial 000 (0-000 if using an internal phone) for Fire, Ambulance or Police
 - Call Campus Emergency on 5430 1122 or Security on 5430 1168
- Emergency Call Points (ECPs)—press to activate an alarm and Security will respond immediately.
Manual Call Points—activate by pressing on the glass, if you see smoke or fire.
